A Word From Pastor...



(1Pe 1:10-12 NIV) "(10) Concerning this salvation, the prophets, who spoke of the grace that was to come to you, searched intently and with the greatest care, (11) trying to find out the time and circumstances to which the Spirit of Christ in them was pointing when he predicted the sufferings of the Messiah and the glories that would follow. (12) It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves but you, when they spoke of the things that have now been told you by those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven. Even angels long to look into these things."

Dearly Beloved,

Peter opens his letter to believers by praising God for giving us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead (1:3-5). This salvation is so incredibly amazing that we greatly rejoice in it, despite suffering grief in

all kinds of trials on earth (1:6-9)! We look forward to the day when the fullness of our salvation is realized and we are delighting in our inheritance in heaven.

In the verses quoted above, Peter reveals that God's salvation through the gospel of grace fascinated the OT prophets and intrigued even the angels themselves! The OT prophets were inspired and directed by the Holy Spirit to predict the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow. What they were being shown by God's Spirit compelled them to search intently and with the utmost care, trying to determine when these events would happen and what type of circumstances would bring these events about! They were amazed by what God was showing them, and they wanted to learn more details and understand more fully the significance of this salvation of grace! They were driven to know personally for themselves when God was going to orchestrate these incredible events. They were undoubtedly hoping that the Lord would bring His Sayior to establish His gracious salvation during their lifetime. But God had a counseling session with them, saying "It involves you and will ultimately benefit you, but it's not happening in your lifetime! Don't dismay! It is coming! It will certainly happen! Your ministry is vital! Your role is to be faithful in serving today. You are part of a valuable relay team running the race. Your role is to run your section of the race in your part of life's history. And you are to faithfully pass the baton of your faith to others who will share the good news of God's grace through Jesus Christ with others! Throughout human history, the Holy Spirit has been working in and through human messengers, predicting the future sufferings of Christ and the wonderful glories to follow and then announcing His arrival, and proclaiming His salvation by grace through faith, and calling people to repentance and faith in Christ! We are called by God's Spirit to actively participate in this baton passing relay race, inviting the people in our world (network of family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors) to receive God's gracious salvation in Christ.

Peter concludes: "Even angels long to look into these things!" Timothy Keller writes: "Angels are incredibly majestic and powerful beings, living in God's presence. Yet there is something that has happened on the earth that is so stupendous that even these immortal beings experience the persistent longing 'to look into these things' (I Peter 1:12). What are these things that could possibly and consistently consume the attention of Godfixated creatures? The answer is......the gospel" (Gospel, J.D. Greear, xiii of the Foreword).

Since the angels never get tired of looking into the gospel, this means that there is no end to gospel exploration...for them or for us! "There are depths in the gospel that are always there to be discovered and applied not only to our ministry and daily Christian life, but above all to the worship of the God of the gospel with renewed vision and humility" (ibid, pp. xiv).

So let us be like the prophets of old and the angels above! Let us be inspired by the heaven sent Holy Spirit to search the depths of Scripture, to mine transforming truths of Christ's humility and wondrous glory for ourselves and for others! Let us offer the gift of new birth through Christ, bringing hope to the hopeless, peace to the fearful and anxious, and unity and reconciliation to the divided and wearing factions!

There is a growing brain and character developing behind that snotty nose and ornery smile. As mothers we are watched and imitated. Eyes and ears are soaking up our actions and being translated into an understanding of the world. Through our long days together our children are learning that God made us to need each other – to need other people to help us live this life. It can be beautiful in its simplicity. Just a hug from you is nourishing to their souls.

Motherhood is meaningful because mopping up a child's spill with a smile is teaching them that they are worth taking care of and how to take care of others. Sweeping the floor, washing the dishes, folding laundry or preparing healthy food is teaching them responsibility and work ethic. 
