# A Word From Pastor...



"(15) "If you love me, keep my commands. (16) And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever-- (17) the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. (18) I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you." (Jhn 14:15-18 NIV)

"(7) But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you." (Jhn 16:7 NIV)

#### Dearly Beloved,

Living the Christian life can be overwhelming. We have unseen demonic forces opposing us; we have a sin nature within us hindering us; we have a world around us that neither sees Jesus Christ for who He truly is nor knows Him that mocks us; and Jesus Himself states, "If you love Me, you will obey what I command" (John 14:15). Attempting to follow Christ in our own strength and wisdom is an impossible task! Jesus Himself know that it is. That's why in John 14:16-18 He adds: "And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever-the Spirit of Truth....But you know Him, for He lives with you and will be in you. I will not have you as orphans; I will come to you."

Jesus has told the disciples that He is leaving them. They can hardly follow Jesus when He is beside them. His presence has changed their lives, but even with Him being in their company, they continue to struggle with self-centeredness, pride, confusion, misunderstanding, doubts, and despair. How can they go on spiritually if He departs.

Jesus promises that He is not abandoning them like street orphans in a ruthless setting where some rebel group is going to sweep them up and overtake them. Jesus know their weaknesses and their opposing forces. He knows what they need in order to successfully follow Him and genuinely express their love for Him! They need another Counselor. They need the Spirit of Truth! They need someone who will not only be with them, but be in them (Jn. 14:17)!

In John 16:7, Jesus makes an amazing statement to His followers, "But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you!" How can it be advantageous for Jesus to depart? How can it be beneficial to be without His presence and His teaching and His miracles and His friendship and His hope?

#### J.D. Greer says:

"At the ascension Jesus did not become an absentee God. He, as God, simply came to His disciples as a different Person. The mystery of the Trinity is that only one God exists in three Persons. Each Person is from the other Two, but in experiencing One, you experience the One God Who is them All. (If your mind feels as if it just exploded, that's okay, Christian theologians have been wrestling with that for centuries!) In the same way that He could tell His followers, "If you have seen Me, you have seen the Father, " so it would be true for Him to say, "When you hear the Spirit, you hear from Me." And, remarkably, He told His disciples that His presence in them would be even better than His presence beside them. Wow. Think about that" (from Jesus, Continued..., pp. 20-21).

As we enter the New Year of 2019, let us thank the Lord that Jesus has given us His Holy Spirit to live with us and to be in us! The Holy Spirit is looking for us to rely on Him through prayer and friendship to follow Jesus and demonstrate our love for Him. The Holy Spirit is not a downgrade from the presence of Jesus! He has equal omnipotence, equal omniscience, and equal omnipresence as Jesus! Ask the Holy Spirit to daily demonstrate how His presence in us is better than Jesus' presence beside us! Happy New Year!





#### WHAT'S COOKING?

CRISPY BAKED CHICKEN LEG QUARTERS (VERY EASY, ONE DISH)

READY IN: 1hr 30mins

SERVES: 4

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 4 skin-on chicken leg quarters, with bone
- ½ cup soy sauce, divided
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder, divided
- 1 teaspoon seasoning salt, divided
- 1 teaspoon dill weed, divided

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Preheat oven to 375.
- Line a large glass baking dish with foil. You can also add a baking rack to the pan to keep the chicken out of the grease and to help air circulate and make it crispier.
- 3. Remove excess fat from chicken quarters.
- 4. Separate the skin from the chicken, taking care that the skin stays attached at most points on the chicken. (You just want a flap. Do not remove the skin).
- 5. Brush the chicken (under the skin) with soy sauce.
- 6. Sprinkle some garlic powder, seasoned salt and dill weed on the chicken under the skin (I estimated the 1 tsp measures. Use as much or as little as you're comfortable with) and rub into the chicken.
- Arrange the leg quarters in the pan, skin side up, taking care not to crowd. They need space to cook properly.
- 8. Brush both sides of the leg quarters with soy sauce.
- 9. Sprinkle the skin with garlic powder, seasoned salt and dill weed (to taste).
- 10. Place on middle rack in oven and bake uncovered for an hour.
- 11. After an hour, increase oven temp to 400 and bake 15 minutes.
- 12. Chicken is done when internal temp reaches 165 (insert meat thermometer at thickest part of thigh, taking care not to touch the bone).

Let stand for 5 minutes before serving.
